## FIRE BYLAW #1372/23 – FURTHER CONSIDERATION

### PURPOSE:

Further consideration to finalize Town of Nanton Fire Bylaw #1372/23, a bylaw for the purpose of providing fire protection and fire prevention in and for the Town of Nanton is requested from Administration.

- *the prohibition of consumer fireworks discharge within the Town of Nanton, and*
- *clarification on processes for permitting Display fireworks and pyrotechnical displays within Nanton*
