NOTICE OF FIRST READING OF BYLAW 1390/24

Take notice that a Bylaw of the Municipality of the Town of Nanton in the Province of Alberta, aimed at Establishing Off-Site Levies referred to as Bylaw # 1390/24, has undergone its first reading by the Council of the Municipality of the Town of Nanton.

The purpose of this Bylaw is to authorize the imposition and collection of off-site levies on land designated for development or subdivision, as per the provisions of the Municipal Government Act.

The "Off-Site Levy Bylaw," includes definitions, administrative procedures, and enforcement measures, delegating authority to the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) for implementation.

The Bylaw specifies conditions under which off-site levies are imposed, requiring development agreements for affected subdivisions, and setting forth procedures for the payment and potential deferral of these levies.

In the event of non-payment, the Bylaw outlines actions the Town may take and mandates that all collected levies be managed in accordance with the Municipal Government Act.

Interested parties are encouraged to review the complete text of the Bylaw, including accompanying schedules and reports, available for examination upon request.
